## About our organization

The Red Crescent Clinic of Tampa Bay is governed by a community Board of Directors who set clinic policies and are actively involved in clinic activities. Our medical director, Dr. Maqsood Siddique, is a well respected local cardiologist who provides the main oversight for our clinical operations. We are a non-profit 501(c) 3



corporation under current federal regulations. All of our providers and staff work on a volunteer basis and comply with the guidelines set by Florida's Department of Health Volunteer Health Care Provider program.

## Services provided by the clinic

- Routine physical exams for children and adults
- General pediatric primary care (sick visits, minor injuries, asthma/allergies, etc.)
- Routine internal medicine primary care (hypertension, diabetes, cholesterol, anticoagulation, minor injuries, infections, depression, etc.)
- Routine screening referrals as needed (colonoscopy, mammograms, prostate blood tests)
- EKG
- Flu vaccines
- Discounted lab tests and radiology exams for patients referred through our clinic
- Eye exam referrals at reduced cost
- Referral to ACCESS Florida for additional state services
